Prior Week Mayoral Meeting Highlights & Links

- Last week's transit funding announcement went well and was broadcast live on facebook from the City's account – re-watch all the details [here](#).
- Clearview discussions: Mayor hosted a meeting with the applicant for revised Clearview development and a small group of Clearview residents to discuss possible changes to the proposal. Follow up meetings are being scheduled with the goal of coming to a mutually agreeable project.
- Inclusivity Committee meeting: Councillor Nisan and the Mayor attended the Burlington Inclusivity Advisory Committee (Councillor Bentivegna is the council designate to the committee) to seek input on potential anti-racism commission or task force. The committee expressed interest in being involved in some capacity with this initiative, once developed.
- Mayor was interviewed by NRU Publishing regarding the pre-application meeting protocol on this week's CPRM agenda. Burlington is one of the few communities that requires such a meeting and has developed some guidelines around them.
