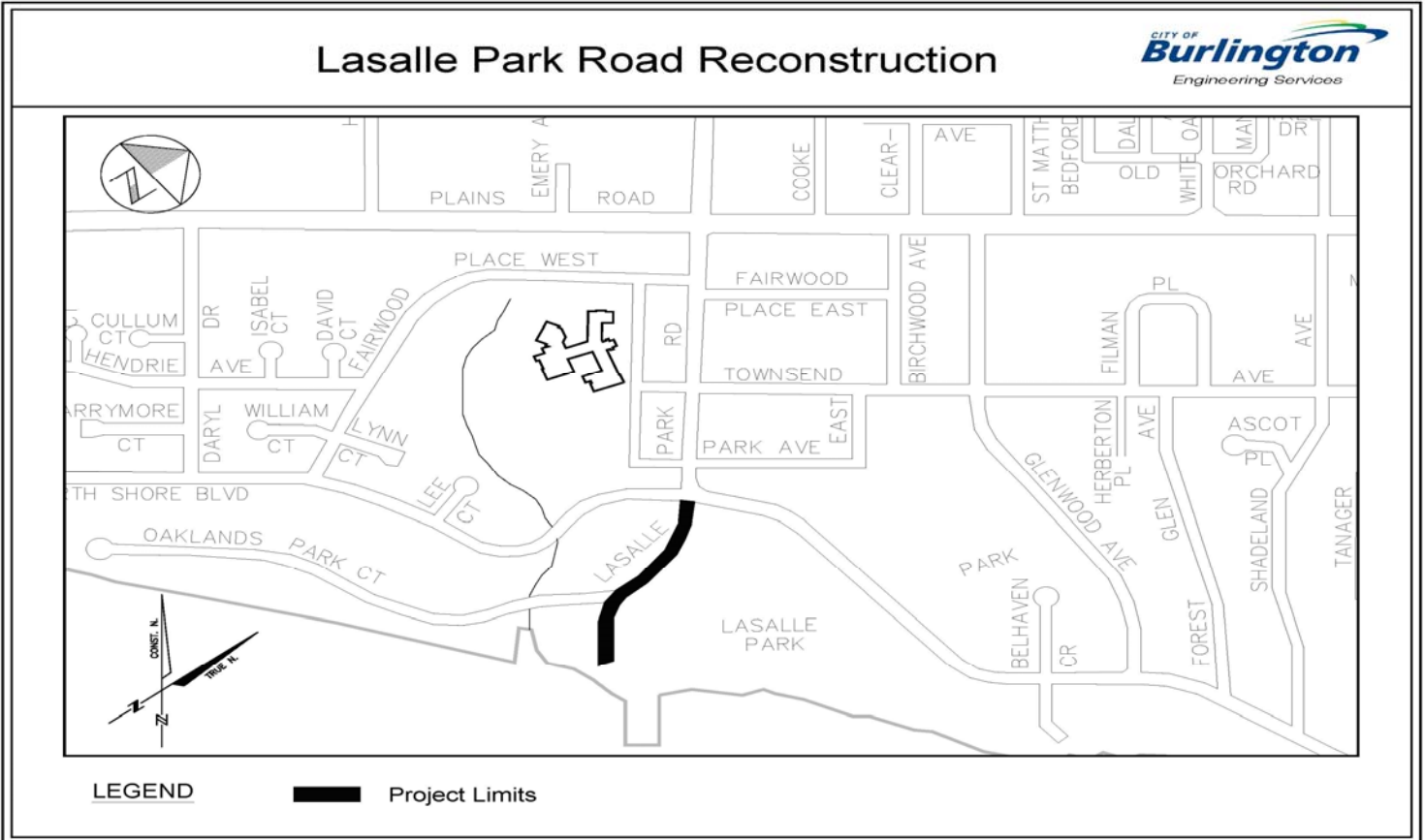
COVID-19 Information

Utility

Disruption to your home internet or telephone service may occur. The City has flagged this concern with utility companies and our goal is to have internet disconnections repaired by the provider within 24 hours. The Contractor will typically contact the utility company, however, if you lose service, please inform your utility provider and the City of the interruption.

Accessing your Property

Lane closures and localized short-term road closures will be necessary to complete the proposed works. During normal construction hours, Monday to Friday, 7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., vehicle access to and from your property may be difficult.

Lawn Irrigation System

If you have a lawn irrigation system within the City's road allowance, please disconnect and remove these sprinkler heads. Please flag all other irrigation heads so they are not damaged. The City is not responsible for damaged heads within the road allowance.

Vibration

You may experience minor vibration from construction equipment. As a precaution, we recommend that you remove or secure objects on shelves and walls.

Dust and Mud

During construction, there will be increased levels of dust and mud throughout the project limits. The contractor is required to manage these impacts.

Road Closures

LaSalle Park Road between Oaklands Park Court and LaSalle Marina will be closed in June for a two-week period, 7:00am to 5:00pm. Additional information to follow.

Mail Delivery

Access to existing community mailbox will be maintained during construction.

Trees

Tree protection barriers will be erected around all trees in the right-of-way and within the construction limits. The specific trees that require removal can be viewed on the project website.
